A BILL to amend the IFC Constitution relating to finances

Patron — Tyler Torres, Interfraternity Council President

Be it enacted by the Interfraternity Council at Virginia Commonwealth University:

1. That the IFC Constitution is amended and reenacted as follows:

Article X: Finances

Section 1. In matters of finance, a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the full membership is required.

Section 2. Dues:

- A. A budget for the Interfraternity Council will be presented by ~~a member of the Interfraternity Council~~ *the Vice President of Operations* for adoption at a regular meeting of the Interfraternity Council.
- ~~B. The budget shall be divided per active member and new member of each fraternity, respectively, at the time the budget is adopted. Dues will be \$10 per active brother and per new member.~~
- C. Dues must be paid ~~forty-five (45) five (5) days after the first day of classes~~ *new member ceremony*, each semester.
 - 1. *Dues paid after five (5) days will receive a \$20 late fee per day, up to fifteen (15) days.*
 - 2. *Dues paid after twenty (20) days will receive a \$30 late fee per day, up to ten (10) days.*
 - 3. *Dues not paid after thirty (30) days will require and immediate meeting with the IFC President, Vice President of Operations, and Advisor, along with the Chapter President and Treasurer.*
- D. *Payments plans may be requested on a chapter-by-chapter basis and will be negotiated by the IFC President and Vice President of Operations and Chapter President and/or Treasurer.*

2. That the provisions of this act take effect immediately.

The Interfraternity Council Cup

The Interfraternity Council Cup, referred to as the IFC Cup from here on out, is a cumulative point system for intramural sports that all IFC Chapters can participate in. The IFC Cup will include basketball, indoor soccer, football, and outdoor soccer. Points will cumulate after the first basketball game of the year and be totaled after the last outdoor soccer game of the year. Only one team per chapter per sport will be counted. Chapters with multiple teams must submit which team they want to use at the beginning of the year. The IFC Cup will run on a calendar year basis. At the end of each calendar year, the chapter with the most points overall will receive the IFC Cup. Points will gained or loss as follows:
